As the Nation comes together to slow the spread of COVID-19, on March 16, the President issued updated Coronavirus Guidance for America, which reads:

“If you work in a critical infrastructure industry, as defined by the Department of Homeland Security, such as healthcare services and pharmaceutical and food supply, you have a special responsibility to maintain your normal work schedule.”

Following Federal & Minnesota State guidelines during the COVID-19 response and in efforts to protect communities while ensuring continuity of functions critical to public health and safety, as well as economic and national security, Commerce Label, Inc. will remain open, functioning, producing, and shipping product to support your businesses.

Because Commerce Label, Inc. is considered a critical supplier (print and label converting) to your organization (E.g.: Health, Hygiene, Food, OTC, Construction, IT, Equipment, etc.) we are considered to be part of the Essential Critical Infrastructure Workforce recognized by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security & Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA).
